



## **Duties of Committee Men & Women**

Each voting district is represented by one male and one female. They are elected every two years and serve both as representatives of the people living in the District and for Workers to help elect Republican candidates at all levels.

1. Know the people in your district.
2. Always be aware of homes for sale or persons moving out of any residence and new persons moving in.
3. Walk the neighborhood to speak to people door to door. Discuss current issues with them dealing with your neighborhood and/or the Township or the County or State.
4. Recruit other interested persons in your voting District to assist with the following:
  - a. Distribution of literature
  - b. Challengers for Election Day at the Polls
  - c. Secure Election Board workers, If needed
  - d. Insuring that all new residents are registered to vote.
  - e. Make certain that deceased and children that have moved away are reported.
5. Assist with walking your district with candidates prior to Election Day when asked.
6. Insure that election results for your district are at the Ewing Township Campaign headquarters
7. Assist in helping during campaign fund raisers.
8. Encourage those able to make contributions either financially or in services for each campaign from within your district.
9. Always be on the lookout for possible persons who may be interested in running for any office either locally, County wide or for State office.
10. Create a contact list of people that are interested in helping with any duties that may occur.
11. Attend Township Council meetings and Monthly Mayor Meetings as often as possible in support of your elected officials.
